On March 22, 2010, Qualifacts' electronic health records, CareLogic Enterprise, achieved ONC-ATCB Complete EHR Certification, passing all certification requirements. Because CareLogic Enterprise is a true Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) platform, every CareLogic customer is already using a fully certified system without upgrades, patches, service interruptions or additional charges.

Qualifacts customers are eligible for all Medicaid and Medicare Meaningful Use incentive payments as soon as they become available.

Why is this important?

Behavioral health and human services providers must demonstrate "meaningful use" of an ONC-certified EHR to qualify for the annual Medicaid or Medicare incentive payments. The Meaningful Use criteria will increase as the program moves from Stage one to two and three so an EHR system must be capable of adapting to future changes and seamlessly integrating those modifications into the users' daily workflow. Since CareLogic Enterprise is delivered as a service, Qualifacts customers are always using the most current product.

Unlike an on-premise system, meaningful use and all other enhancements to CareLogic are deployed automatically, seamlessly and at no additional cost.

How much are the incentive payments?

Both Medicaid and Medicare are offering incentive payments. Eligible Professionals (EPs) can receive up to \$63,750 over six years from the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program. EPs need only adopt, implement or upgrade to a certified EHR in their first year of participation and then

demonstrate "meaningful use" for the remaining participation years. The program is voluntarily offered by individual states, 11 of which have already begun disbursing payments.

Under the Medicare Incentive Program, EPs can receive up to \$44,000 over five years and must begin participation in 2012 to receive the maximum payment. After 2015, a penalty will be applied for all Medicare EPs that do not successfully demonstrate Meaningful Use.

Who is eligible?

Incentive payments are made to Eligible Professionals (EPs) and the EP assigns the payment to an agency. For most behavioral health agencies, Medicare defines an EP as a physician only. The Medicaid program also includes nurse practitioners.
